



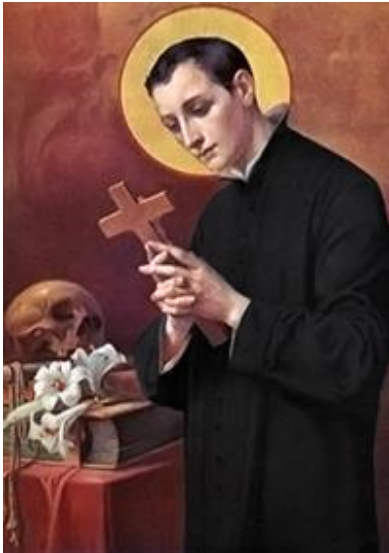

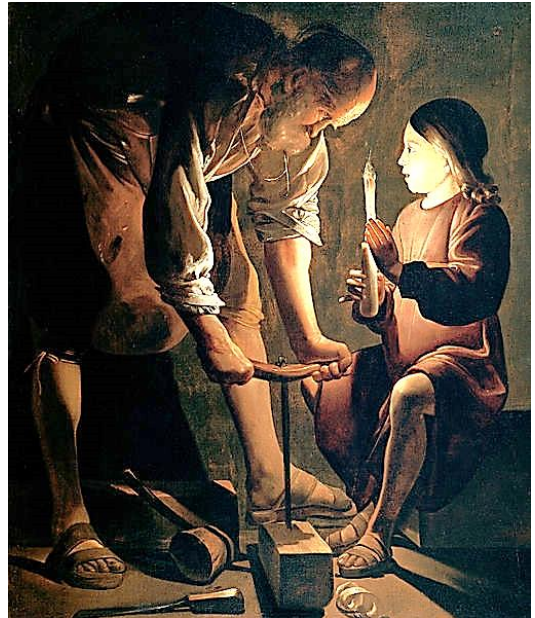

ST. ALOYSIUS' NEWS

CHURCH OPEN

Following the diocesan communiqué ([cf. June 09, 2021, No. 39](#)), places of worship have been granted permission to welcome up to 250 participants at each Mass, not including members of the liturgical team, effective **Monday, June 14**, when Montreal and Laval regions transitioned from orange to yellow zone status. The government's de-confinement plan allows for the majority of Quebec regions to transition to green zone status as of **Monday, June 28, 2021**. We will be keeping you abreast of the situation concerning our diocese as soon as we have those details.

Please note that all current health safety measures for Mass attendance (listed below) will continue to be observed into this latest phase.

Thanks to our team of volunteers, Mass is open to the public Sundays at 9:30 a.m. at Ste-Louise-de-Marillac Church (7901 Ste-Claire St.). Doors open at 9:15 a.m.

Registration still required

Although the maximum number of people permitted per celebration at Ste-Louise-de-Marillac Church allows for us to accept all participants, we kindly ask that you continue to register. To do so, please call the office at 514-351-3281 and leave your name with Joanne, as well as those of any other family members who will be attending. This will help facilitate contact-tracing should the need arise. Joanne requests to please not send any messages to the parish Facebook page to reserve your place.

Important reminders

- In compliance with required health safety measures, entry to the church will be restricted to the main doors on Honoré-Beaugrand St. (corner Ste-Claire St.)
- Please take your seat immediately upon arrival. Physical distancing of two metres between people from different households must be

maintained at all times, as does the compulsory wearing of standard procedural masks.

Important reminders (cont'd)

- Departure: After Mass, everyone must exit the church by the side doors located at the north-end of the building (either side of the sanctuary).
- As announced at Mass, please remember that singing during Mass and gathering at the back/front of the church either before or after Mass, are not permitted.

We thank you for your patience and collaboration in helping ensure the safety of staff, volunteers and parishioners as we enter into this next phase of liturgical life.

RECONCILIATION WITH INDIGENOUS PEOPLE, IN ACTION: HOLY NAME OF JESUS PARISH, LAVAL

The recent discovery of the remains of 215 school children on the grounds of a former residential school in Kamloops has shed light on a dark part of our history as Canadians and as a Church.

There is much work to do to bring about reconciliation and share the truth. For our parish, we wish to take steps towards that truth and reconciliation. We will be hosting an online event. *Reconciliation with Indigenous People in Action* will take place **Tuesday, June 29** at 7 p.m. via the cloud platform, *Zoom*.

Two of our parishioners will lead us in an evening of deeper understanding and awareness of the cultures of the many Indigenous Peoples of our country and we will conclude with a time of prayer to remember those affected by the traumas of the residential school system and all those indigenous men, women and children who are still suffering from continued injustices.
