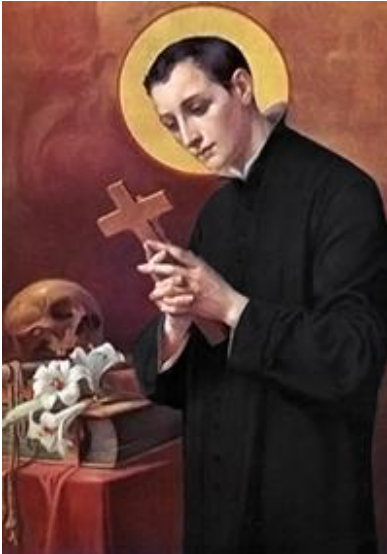

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND THE INTEGRATION OF ENGLISH-SPEAKING NEWCOMERS IN QUEBEC

On Wednesday, March 15, from 10am-5pm at the Centre Sheraton Montreal (1201 René-Lévesque Blvd. West) the **Quebec Community Groups Network** will be hosting a one-day conference on community engagement and the successful integration of newcomers. This pre-forum to the **National Metropolis Conference** aims to bring together representatives from various sectors and various regions to discuss how newcomers (immigrants, refugees and migrants) integrate Quebec society through Quebec's English-speaking communities and institutions, including faith-based organizations.
