

GOD?

Today Holy Mother the Church is celebrating the Solemnity of the Trinity. I was wondering what I could say on such a subject. Now I am not a theologian; I am not even much of a physicist or a Physics teacher. I was married for forty-five years, loved my wife dearly and we had three children, between the ages of forty-nine and fifty-one years. I am addicted to online Harlequin romances, curious about Orthodoxy and geopolitics, so what I will say here is basically tentative, but perhaps there will be a certain amount of truth in my madness.

God is an Eternal Explosion. He has three Manifestations. He constantly self-generates, constantly exploding in Father, Son and Holy Spirit. He has to, because He is Love Eternal, and love is a movement towards the Other Person and generates yet another Person. The sacrament of Holy Matrimony is the best approximation of Who God is. It is the coming together of two persons who become one, really become one, and finding it so difficult to live without the other, without being able to cherish the other as greater than themselves, and as their light in the darkness of the world. It is the working together to create a family, a real family, with each supporting each other, looking after each other, helping each other, and ready to give their life for their family. It implies the acceptance of a totally new situation, the growing of a wife into a mother, with all the physiological and psychological changes taking place. It requires the husband to be attuned to the needs of his wife, to be there for her during the difficult months of pregnancy and especially in the pain of childbirth. It means for the husband to recognize the great sacrifices of motherhood. It is in the love of a small, defenceless, fragile little being, totally dependent and requiring nurturing, patience, self-sacrifice.



Many, when thinking about the Trinity, see an equilateral triangle. I suppose I should be pleased with that image. Unfortunately, I now see that image as that created by a child rather than that of a grown-up. It is so easy to draw it and discuss its geometry. The problem with this is that life is messy. Geometry is so simple, elegant. I chose Physics because it was the easiest subject: no real people involved and a rather elegant solution to basic problems. Love is on a totally different plane, infinitely more real and important. The proof of that is that God is Love, and so must be many Persons who love each Other and decided to create the World so that many more may become part of that Eternal Explosion of Supreme Love.

HAPPY Father's Day

God took the strength of a mountain, the majesty of a tree, the warmth of a summer sun, the calm of a quiet sea, the generous soul of nature, the comforting arm of night, the wisdom of the ages, the power of the eagle's flight, the joy of a morning in spring, the faith of a mustard seed, the patience of eternity, the depth of a family need, then God combined these qualities. When there was nothing more to add, He knew His masterpiece was complete, and so, He called it...Dad.
