

LAMB?

Today, Holy Mother the Church is celebrating the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. It is known as Corpus Christi, the name of my Oxford College, founded in 1517 by the then Bishop Richard Fox. His College is not the only Oxford College whose name has a theological connotation: you also have Jesus College and Trinity College, as well as Saint Anne and Saint John, among others.

In Saint John's Gospel, we have John the Baptist call Jesus «the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world». Saint John makes it clear that Jesus died on the Cross when the Passover lambs were to be killed in the Temple.

What ceremony were the Jews celebrating at Passover? The Jews were to eat the lamb once roasted with unleavened bread, in haste, after having bludgeoned the lintels of their house with the blood of the lamb; that was a sign to make sure that those inside the house would be saved from the plague that would bring death to others.



In every animal sacrifice (except the holocaust, where the animal was totally burnt on the altar), most of the animal is eaten by those who offer this sacrifice. In the sacrifice of the Mass, the Lamb is offered to God on the altar and is eaten by the participants of this sacrifice, i. e. those at church. Jesus' body is offered in the form of bread and His blood in the form of wine, just like He instructed us to do.

Now I do not know if it's just me, but I find it strange to offer Someone to God and be the one whom He is giving sustenance to. In the holocaust, the one who offers the sacrifice is not getting anything for himself, but in this case, it seems a crooked deal. We at the same time offer as one and receive as one! To me, it is as if we pretend to give to God something which God then sanctifies and gives us back magnified a hundredfold!

Well, I suppose it is a little bit like all creation, which God gives us so generously. He constantly showers us with His gifts, and there is no greater gift than the Body and Blood of the Lord: God providing us with Himself.

Now there is a Chinese saying used as a curse: «May you live in interesting times.» This is surely the case right now, when we have the President of the United States demanding the unconditional capitulation of another country which is backed by a large part of the World. The West is disintegrating under our eyes at breakneck speed, where there is a possibility that the West might retain its hegemony by the use of nuclear weapons and so through the World's total destruction: the «nuclear holocaust», offered to the Enemy, Lucifer Satan himself. Let us hope that the Lamb will prevail in this world. He will definitely prevail in the World to come.
