

### **MISSIONARIES**


The following text is my English translation of an Editorial from Brother Jacques Matthieu, Capuchin, for the Magazine «Missionaries Together»

My Father is working always and I am working also... strange words from Jesus!

Since the World's creation, our Blessed Trinity is working in unity, and nothing is finished!

The powerful of this world, the billionaires, some political leaders, give a sorry image of our reality, our reason to exist, our mission on Earth, and our vocation. Riches, power, the goods of this earth do seem to be desirable and full of promise. It is a horizontal life, shopping centre style, where forgetting both our common Father and the little ones are absolutely obvious.

Where is hope? There is a Truth, a Life, a Depth outside of material goods: it is Love and Service, Listening and Partaking. It is in the building of a brotherly and a multicultural world, it is the dawning of a world where the human individual grows in wisdom, in equilibrium and in happiness. The song says: to make a man, my God how it is long! But doesn't one need time, silence and solitude to become who we are, a son or daughter of God, inhabited and loved by God, on an always changing way?



Lately I was thinking about the **action of God**. As if the creative action of God was always truly alive and acting in order to accompany His children as they are called to come back to the Father, to the Father's house.



What is asked of everyone, is to turn to the Father, to talk to Him, to listen to Him, to let Him act. It will take time, but it is lasting. We will become like God's Son, to build a large family, the Church.

So do we need missionaries as it is God who acts, works, changes the soul in each of us? **Does God need us?** The grandmothers that have saved Russia by keeping the faith alive during the communist years. When the Lord establishes Himself and resides in someone, that person shines and sometimes says luminous words which do good. God moves through us. God loves through us. God acts with us and through us.

Jesus told us: ask and you shall receive! He wants to use us! He loves being able to **freely** act in us and through us. He loves that we believe... in Him... He loves that we give Him the freedom to act. He loves to make Himself present and to give Peace and Joy through us.

The subtle presence of the Lord... He is goodness, sweetness, humility, always acting.

In the sacrament, He is there, in the bread of the Eucharist, in the forgiveness, in the healing of the holy oil, in the love of spouses. The Blessed Trinity is acting, and He loves acting in us and through us. Let us welcome Him, let us welcome the Wisdom of God, let us welcome His kind and creative action. Let us become who we are, the sons and daughters of God.

May we walk with God this summer in whatever we do, wherever we go. Protect us God, as we travel, returning us back home safely. Walking with honesty and courage and walking with love, respect, and concern for the feelings of others. May we talk to God this summer — every day and in every situation.
