OUR PARISH

I mentioned at the end of last week's Mass the fact that within two days we had witnessed three sacraments: Holy Matrimony, Reconciliation and Eucharist. In fact, a while back, we also had Confirmation. All this shows a Parish which is alive and vibrant. Our few minutes of coffee after Mass where we can actually talk to each other, the «hoping for Hope», the choir, our readers, our Mass servers, our Mass online on two digital platforms, all this shows our people's commitment to our Parish. There is nothing more important than that commitment. Our giving to those in need through HOPE, our giving to our Parish's life, our prayers for one another, all these are very important. We must never forget that in the prayer for each other's private intentions we show that solidarity, which is essential in a Christian community. We do not need to know necessarily the needs of others, what we need is to trust each other.

That we form a Christian Community, a group committed to the Gospel, to working for each other, with each other, to achieve together what God wants each of us to become, that is a very urgent and essential objective. That we always have volunteers, people willing to cover when someone happens to be unavailable, this is wonderful.

We form the Church militant. Each Parish is a small outfit. In each we have a priest, sometimes a deacon: those are our Commissioned Officers. But as we all know, military outfits are essentially made of soldiers and Non-Commissioned Officers (NCO's). These are basically the one's required to form the outfit, and it is their training and actions which constitute the outfit. Badly trained soldiers mean dead soldiers and military disaster. Well trained ones mean survival into Eternal Life.

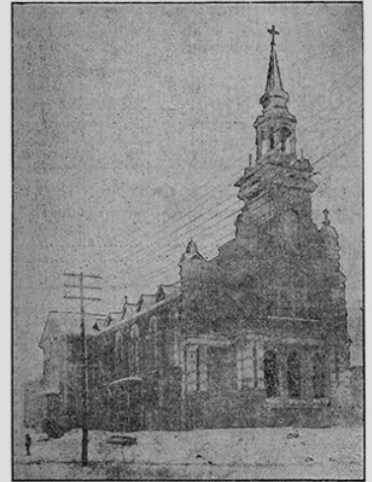

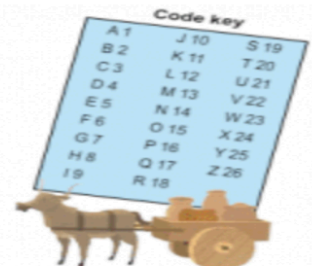
