THE WORD

A few days ago, a young man was shot to death by a sniper as he was debating his faith in a public meeting. The young man was Charlie Kirk, a Presbyterian, one of the main Protestant Christian denominations in the USA. He had a lot of friends who were Roman Catholic. In fact, he had married one. Had he been a Catholic, he could have been recognized as a Saint immediately as he died expressing his faith in our Lord.

Now he was confessing his faith in a public assembly; he was not talking *ex cathedra*; he was debating, and in fact, he was someone you could convince if your arguments were better. His position was changing on many points, bringing him closer to Roman Catholicism; his position on Israel was also shifting, to the point that some people are wondering if his assassination was triggered by this. His position on Ukraine was also rather different than that of the powers that be. In other words, he had made himself a lot of enemies, as his influence on young people was constantly growing.

He was defending what is now often referred to as «family values», the values that are the ones our ancestors defended, the ones their own ancestors defended. As these are contrary to the ones that our elites espoused, he was considered very dangerous by them. Words have an effect on people, especially when spoken in honesty.

The major point is that he was ready to debate, to discuss, to change his mind if he was convinced to be wrong. He was honest, vulnerable, authentic. He respected his opponents, always ready to learn from others.

We find many kinds of people. There are the intransigent, who think they have all the answers, the preachers, who can express great truths with great clarity but are not ready to put their beliefs in question; and then there are people like Charlie Kirk, who are ready to put their beliefs on the line. As such they show a great love for the Word, as they are also ready to put themselves on the line.

I hope that what I wrote is truthful. A lot has been written on Charlie Kirk and I hope what I wrote is true to his character. If not, well, at least I have described a man to my own heart.
