

#### WITNESSES?

I often suggest at the end of the Sunday Mass for the whole congregation to pray to God to increase our numbers. What does that really entail? Is it just a nice formula to give at the end of Mass to increase my standing in the community? That is not my intention. I am not good at judging anyone, including myself, so I will leave others to answer that question.

According to the Oxford dictionary, prayer is a solemn expression of thanks or request to God. This implies the belief that He can actually do what is asked. How? I certainly do not

have a clue, which is something else which I do not know. All I know, is that Jesus promised us that if two or three ask the same thing from His Father, it will happen. Is His word sufficient? I think so, or to reinforce this, I believe so. Just like I believe that it is the Body of Christ that I distribute at communion, something that just looks like a white wafer. Why again? Because Jesus said so according to the Gospels. And, I believe the Gospels, the utterances and actions of God-made-man.



Am I right to believe that? What proof do I have that it is the truth? The only answer I can give you is that I have a firm basic belief that it is true. No one has to believe me or trust me on that point, obviously. I know many who do not, for all kinds of reasons, reasons that are often based on incidents in their lives which make them deny my beliefs. And who am I to judge their decisions?

Now, what I have is a deep-seated belief that many others, people much wiser and smarter than me, have also shared at various times in history and in various places. And I certainly take these people as more reliable witnesses to the faith that I also believe in.

One thing is certain, the basic beliefs, tenets of the one, catholic, orthodox, apostolic, Christian Church have been shared for the best part of nineteen centuries and are still going strong. Our faith is that of our fathers, as the hymn goes.

Yesterday, we celebrated the Solemnity of All Saints, a day to acknowledge the countless prayerful individuals who put their trust in the Lord and got from Him a room in His Father's House; and today, we acknowledge their fellow believers who are putting on the special clothes required to enter the celebration of the marriage of the Lamb. May God bless us all. Amen.
