

PROPS...

During the week, I try to go to Mass at the church nearest to my residence. Last Friday, that was the 9:00 a.m. Mass at Sainte-Claire. Mass is in their Chapel of Saint-Victor. Behind that altar you will find a beautiful icon which I have not been able to find online. That kind of icon of Jesus is normally considered as one of the pantocrator. It shows Jesus looking at us in a solemn attitude with piercing eyes; the term pantocrator means «ruler of everything», that is the universe.



Icons, as we all know, are associated with Orthodoxy-like statues in Catholicism. Original movable icons are painted on a wood tablet. First a gesso, or primer, is applied to the wood, and then paint is added in very light layers to produce the desired image. Today copies can be made and it is such a reproduction that is found behind the altar, but many hand-painted ones are produced every year and, just like rosaries and other catholic images, they are specially blessed.

On this point, many Russian Orthodox soldiers carry smaller versions of such icons between their breast plate and their chest. On their President's last birthday, a few soldiers, some from their hospital beds, gave him their icons which had stopped shrapnel or bullets. The President was very touched by such a gesture.

Of course, immovable icons can also be produced using different coloured and shaped ceramics to great effect (mosaics). The one of the Theotokos found in the Russian Cathedral of the Armed Forces was outlined in a previous blog.

At the Mass I mentioned above, someone decided to play a song written by Patrick Richard in 1984, a song which moved me greatly. The tune is simple and catchy, The words of the refrain are simply (in the original): «Mon Dieu, tu es grand, tu es beau, Dieu vivant, Dieu très haut, tu es le Dieu d'amour; Mon Dieu, tu es grand, tu es beau, Dieu vivant, Dieu très haut, Dieu présent, en toute création»

When you add this song to staring at the icon, if you are like me, in my present state, you cry and mean those words... you pray those words, you love.

By the way, there exists an English equivalent to the French song, one that I first heard in a Pentecostal Prayer Meeting at Denton, close to Oxford, one we sometimes sing in this Parish: «O Lord my God». I react the same way...


GRACE DART EXTENDED CARE
