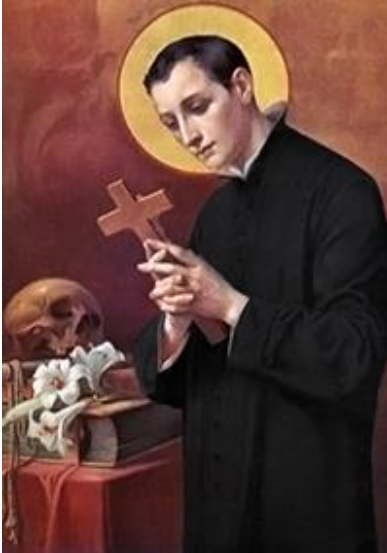

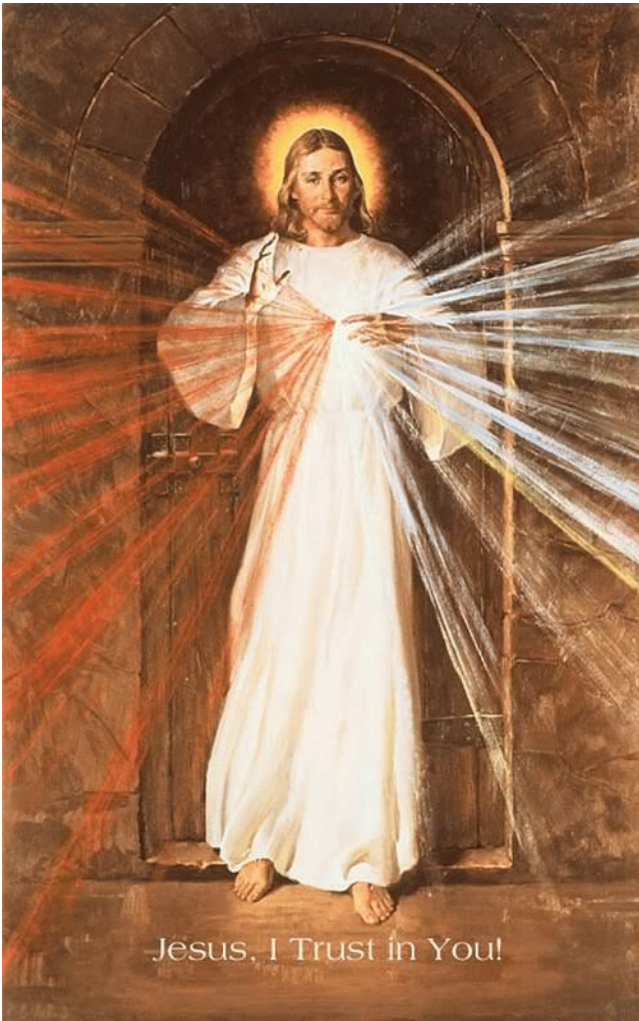

Following the recent decree from the *Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments*, Archbishop Christian Lépine will preside at a special Mass on **Wednesday, April 22**, entitled "In Time of Pandemic".

PUBLIC INVITATION TO PAUSE IN SILENCE FOR PRAYER AS MONTREAL CHURCH BELLS CONTINUE TO RING THROUGHOUT THE CITY
