



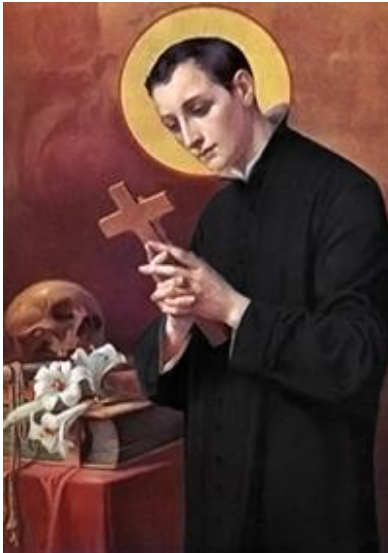

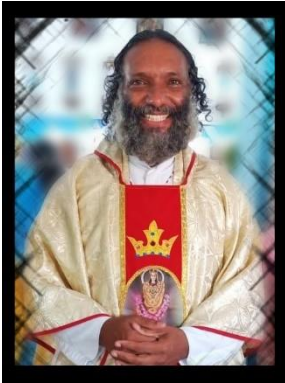

Message from Fr. Donbosco Mawdsley, SMA



God is Good, all the time and all the time God is good. I am really happy to meet you all through this small article. First let me introduce myself. I am Fr. Donbosco Mawdsley, SMA. I belong to the Society of the Missions for Africa (SMA), a missionary congregation for Africa. SMA was founded by Most. Rev. Bp. Marion de Brésillac in 1856. At present SMA serves in about 19 African countries. Africa is a continent with 59 independent countries.

I am from India. I come from a small family with just two children, my sister and myself. With humble gratitude I remember my mother for offering me to the Lord, my grandmother and my sister for their love and support. I lost my father just few months before my birth, so these were my world and all.

I heard about SMA in 1991 and joined the SMA in 1992. I was sent to the Philippines for my spiritual, at the end of which I made my first oath. In 1997 I was sent to Tanzania, an East African country. I did my theology in Kenya. I was ordained a missionary priest on the 22nd of May 2003 with the motto – “To love the one who sent me and to love the ones to whom I am sent.”

I was sent back to Kenya for my first parish as a priest. It was in Kitengela, a little town with a multi-tribal clan, cultural group. The parish is dedicated to St. Monica. After about six months I was sent to the Diocese of Lodwar in the northwest region of Kenya. The Catholic Diocese of Lodwar shares the same administrative boundaries as the Turkana District. The District is hot, dry and dusty for most of the year. It is a kind of semi-desert. The headquarters of the District is Lodwar; after which the Diocese is named. In the Turkana language, “Lodwar” means “place of bitterness”. The place is so hard to live in; the people have named it Lodwar. In the diocese of Lodwar I served from 2004 to 2008 in different offices: Assistant Parish Priest, Bishop’s Secretary, Language Co-ordinator and PMS Director. In all those years I have always experienced God’s protection, Our Mother’s maternal care and the people’s love.

I was assigned in Rome, at our Generalate, from 2008 to 2014 as the local finance administrator. I was given an opportunity to study along with my work. Therefore, I did my licentiate and doctorate in Canon Law. From 2014-2019 I was appointed to Arputha Amala Annai Parish in India. I was also helping at a major seminary as a Canon Law professor and as a judge in the Ecclesiastical Tribunal.

When the term came to an end I was sent here to Canada and was assigned as an Associate Pastor at Missione Maria Ausiliatrice (Mary Help of Christians Mission, in RDP). As the pastor of the mission, Fr. Jean-Pierre Couturier is the Parochial Administrator at Dominic Savio Mission and St. Aloysius Parish, and I assist him in these places.

May St. Aloysius intercede for us “to reach out to others through the Holy Spirit like Jesus”. God is good...
